Taylor'd Thoughts for February

I was talking with a friend the other day about the flood of 1977 in downtown Bangor when I was working at a local law firm. It was unusually warm, with rain that day. The Kenduskeag plaza started to flood and we were urged to move our cars from the plaza as soon as possible. I left the office building and set out across the plaza. I was parked by the old Merrill Merchants building and by the time I got there the water was already coming into the plaza. There was another office worker getting into a VW bug which was already starting to float in the water – I knocked on the car window and told her she needed to get out and get to dry land as the car was not going to be drivable. She did. I saw that my car now had water up by the tires and I knew I was not going to be able to get it out of the plaza. I headed back across on the bridge to join my friends on the opposite side.

By the time I reached the parking meters on the other side the water was up to my chest and rushing past me, with chunks of ice. I was scared. I could see dry land but also could see lots of cars going under and people wading out of the water. At that point a big van with the windows down roared up to me and stopped, and a young man reached across the seat and said, “get in” – he half dragged me into the van as the water continued to rise. He said, “we’ll go as far as we can” and a few dozen feet later, we hit a submerged car. He jumped out and landed on the ROOF of another car and had me jump to him – off he went into the rushing water with the assurance that he would not let me go. I jumped in after him and away we went, swimming for the shore in the cold water. He got me to dry land! I was soaking wet, cold and scared, not seeing any of my friends at this point on the shore.

I started back to the office and before I got there, my boss spotted me and rescued me in his car. I always felt like the young man in the van had saved my life that day, but I never even knew his name. Every time I go to the plaza I think of that February long ago and am always grateful for the young man in the van.

All the King's Men

(1949 - 110 minutes)

Wednesday, February 3, 7:15 (PMR)

Willie Stark ([Broderick Crawford](#)) is a model politician -- until he's corrupted by the very system he tries to reform. Based on the cautionary Pulitzer Prize-winning novel, All the King's Men was nominated for seven Academy Awards; it won Best Picture, as well as Best Actor and Actress for stars Crawford and [Mercedes McCambridge](#) (later the voice of the possessed Regan in The Exorcist).

Seven Brides for Seven Brothers:

50th Anniversary Edition

(1954 - 102 minutes)

Saturday, February 6, 7:15 (PMR)

Set on a ranch in the Oregon Territory, this rousing musical tells the story of Adam ([Howard Keel](#)) and his six unruly brothers. Adam marries Milly ([Jane Powell](#)), who's appalled by the motley crew and takes it upon herself to tame them. Longing to become husbands like their brother, the boys go into town and kidnap six lovely women for themselves. Not without chaos and uproar, the boys and their wives eventually find happiness.

The Miracle of Morgan's Creek

(1944 - 99 minutes)

Wednesday, February 10, 7:15 (PMR)

In this daring, slapstick farce that's become a classic, [Betty Hutton](#) plays a small-town girl who attends an all-night party and suddenly finds herself "in the family way." Trouble is, she can't remember who the father might be. Directed by [Preston Sturges](#), this hilarious comedy features [Eddie Bracken](#) as a loveably nerdy suitor who's willing to marry Hutton. Williams Demarest, Brian Donlevy and [Akim Tamiroff](#) co-star.

Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs

(1937 - 84 minutes)

Wednesday, February 17, 7:15 (PMR)

Walt Disney broke new ground in 1937 with this animated feature-length film, based on the famous fairy tale collected by the Brothers Grimm, about a jealous queen, her beautiful stepdaughter, seven lovable dwarfs and a handsome prince. The Oscar-

nominated classic includes the songs "Whistle While You Work," "Heigh-Ho" and "Some Day My Prince Will Come" (which became a jazz standard via trumpeter Miles Davis in the 1950s).

The Maltese Falcon

(1941 - 100 minutes)

Saturday, February 20, 7:15 (PMR)

[Humphrey Bogart](#) stars as private eye Sam Spade in this Oscar-nominated noir classic that finds the sultry Miss Wonderly ([Mary Astor](#)) seeking out protection from a man named Thursby. Spade's partner ([Jerome Cowan](#)) takes the case -- but he winds up dead, along with Thursby. Spade's subsequent hunt for the killer leads him into a world of deception and double-crossing, as a trio of criminals searches for a priceless statue known as the Maltese Falcon.

Cirque du Soleil: Alegria

(2003 - 90 minutes)

Wednesday, February 24, 7:15 (PMR)

Alegria is a beautifully filmed fantasy about the strange and fascinating world inhabited by circus performers, including how they relate to each other on an interpersonal level when not wowing the capacity crowds. Just sit back and relax while members of the famed French-Canadian troupe Cirque du Soleil perform their inimitable, mesmerizing magic.

Young Mr. Lincoln

(1939 - 100 minutes)

Saturday, February 27, 7:15 (PMR)

With [Henry Fonda](#) in the title role, this biopic follows the future president through his early law career -- with the drama focusing on his defense of two brothers unjustly accused of murder -- and traces Honest Abe's budding political consciousness. Sure-handed direction, powerful performances and strong writing (the film received an Oscar nomination for Best Original Screenplay) characterize this highly fictionalized tale from [John Ford](#).
